Doctor's Availability

Some of our doctors are not here every day so if you wish to see a particular doctor you may need to wait a little longer. Routine appointments are bookable up to 3 months in advance. Telephone appointments are also available with either a doctor or nurse,

We aim to offer an appointment for urgent cases the same day .

We are currently operating a telephone triage service for ALL appointment requests. Patients will be seen face to face if the doctor feels it is clinically appropriate.

Improved Access Clinic's - There are routine and urgent evening and weekend appointments available locally at surgeries and other locations. These appointments are bookable through the practice, please contact Reception for more information or see our website.

If you wish to have a chaperone at your appointment please just ask at reception.

Prescriptions

We are a dispensing practice and can therefore dispense to any of our patients living more than a mile from a chemist. For patients living within a mile of the chemist, your routine prescriptions will be sent direct to the local chemist for your collection or to a chemist of your choice. We can offer electronic transmission of prescriptions in some cases.

We do ask that you give us 48 hours notice (2 full working days) prior to collecting your repeat medication. The local chemist requests 72 hours notice. We prefer you to use the Repeat Prescriptions Online Service, or telephone the Prescription Order Line 0300 421 1215, however, you may call in person with the prescription request. If you need medication urgently in hours please call the Dispensary, out of hours call 111 or some pharmacies offer an emergency medication scheme.
